



MEMORIAL ENDOWMENT ART EDUCATOR SCHOLARSHIP FUND Two \$1000.00 Scholarship to be awarded.

The MAEA will sponsor two Art Education Scholarships to a Junior or Senior college student who is enrolled in an art education program in the state of Michigan. This scholarship is to aid students who are seriously pursuing a career and course of study to become an art educator. The MAEA believes this program will benefit the arts in Michigan. Any student demonstrating a commitment to art education who wishes to continue as a full time student at an accredited university is urged to apply. The scholarships will be awarded based on the quality and presentation of artwork, references, and personal narrative submitted. All awards will be made without regard to race, creed, color, sex, religion, or national origin.

Eligibility

1. A Resident of the State of Michigan.
2. Junior or Senior status or a Bachelors Degree in Art or Art Education working toward certification in Art Education in the fall of 2010
3. Admitted to an accredited Education Dept. at a Michigan college or university.
4. An overall G.P.A. of 3.0.
5. You must be current member of MAEA or willing to join to receive this award.

NOTE: Due to the nature of the scholarship, the amount will be about \$1,000.00.

Application

Must include the following:

1. A portfolio of 10 original works of art submitted on 35mm slides or a CD in sleeve protectors. Print on each slide or directory with: student's name, size of work and medium. Mark an arrow indicating the top of the slide, displaying each individual piece, as it would be viewed.
2. Two letter of recommendation from art or art education professors verifying the student's commitment and eligibility.
3. One to three page personal narratives stating your philosophy of art education, how you would implement your philosophy and how the scholarship would assist you.
4. An official copy of the student's transcript sent directly to the Michigan Art Education Association. C/O Scholarship Chair.

DEADLINE: *Must be postmarked by midnight April 30. Notification of the award will be in June and given for the following year. Recognition and scholarship check will be presented at the MAEA fall conference.*
