ART 597AB/ART 697AC Lasting Impressions - Ceramics (3 credit hours)

August 1-13, 2010

Instructor: Jane White, Director of Adult Education at Pewabic Pottery. Jane has taught ceramics classes for the Center for Creative Studies, Central Michigan University, Eastern Michigan University, and Ann Arbor's Guild.

Course Description: Designed for ambitious students with some experience with clay. In gathering impressions and translating them into clay, this intensive course draws upon exploration of Beaver Island's beauty and charm as inspiration for forms, which will be fired in raku and other low temperature firings. Students who are focused, ambitious, flexible, and playful will thrive and be inspired by this ceramics course. Tuition, along with a \$25 lab fee is required at registration.



ART 334/ART 597AC/ART 697AA Watercolor Painting (3 credit hours)

August 8-20, 2010

Instructor: John Swanstrom, Professor Emeritus, Central Michigan University. John has instructed the Watercolor Painting course on Beaver Island for 21 years and was a faculty member in the CMU Art Department for 32 years.

Course Description: Designed for beginning, intermediate and advanced watercolorists. Course emphasis is placed on a solid grounding in transparent watercolor painting techniques, color composition and a color interpretation of the Beaver Island environment. Students **must** have basic drawing skills.

All individuals participating in Art sessions on Beaver Island must be registered as either a credit or audit student. Students must register for credit first and will then be instructed on the new process to arrange for room and board.
